ABOUT THE FOUNDATION

Who is Forestville Education Foundation?

The Foundation is led by a volunteer Board of Directors of up to fifteen (15) members who meet monthly, along with Foundation Members which includes parents, staff, and community volunteers.

What does the Foundation do? What do we fund?

The Foundation raises money through memberships (parent and community donations) and a variety of events, including: Dine and Donate, Valentine's Flower Sale, Pasta Feed, Crafts Fair, Holiday Window Painting, Bake Sales and our Annual Gala. The Foundation also organizes the annual Harvest Fair and Staff Appreciation Luncheon. Money raised is then used to fund programs, events and activities for the students of Forestville School (to supplement what the district provides). These include: Art, Music, Band, Sports, Classroom Materials, Field Trips, Assemblies, Special Programs & more.

How can parents request funds for their children's classroom?
